

The European Commission supports Biome Makers technology for its expansion in Europe

The program has selected 246 companies and offers a total amount of 12.2M€

The European Union places a priority focus on innovation in agriculture, and chooses the Spanish subsidiary of the startup Biome Makers Inc. to participate in the R&D financing program, Horizon 2020.

The goal of the program is to encourage the activity of companies to achieve a faster implementation of their innovations in the market. Through the financing offered, the Commission offers SMEs the opportunity to access the same tools as larger companies, thereby increasing their competitiveness.

The SME Instrument (Horizon 2020) is structured in three phases that cover the different stages of the innovation cycle. Biome Makers has passed the first phase obtaining a positive evaluation that will allow access to the initial financing to understand the potential market and start to expand its activity in Europe. Overcoming this first phase will allow the company to access financing within the framework of the following phases. In a second phase Biome Makers aims to develop large-scale pilots to attract the attention of the market. Finally, in a third phase, the company's access to private capital and innovative environments will be facilitated.
